Procedures and Rules

1. General Music Procedures
 1. Enter the room quietly and before the bell rings.
 2. Get your journal out of the crate marked with your period number.
 3. Take a writing desk if you would like one (this is not required).
 4. Sharpen pencils before the bell rings. I would prefer that you use a mechanical pencil.
 5. Complete the posted assignment in your journal. Make sure you write down the assignment completely.
 6. Begin your assignment as soon as the bell rings.
 7. At the end of class, place journals and writing desks where you found them and in neat stacks.
2. Choir Procedures
 1. Enter the room quietly and before the bell rings.
 2. Get your music folder and make sure your mechanical pencil has lead.
 3. Place all belongings under your assigned seat.
 4. At the end of class, place your folder in the correct slot by number. Failure to do so will result in folder placement seminars the following day.
3. Students may not leave the classroom for any non-emergency reason during the first and last ten minutes of the period.
4. Use the water fountain before or after class. You may bring bottled water; you may not leave class to get a drink. Exceptions will be made in case of hiccups.
5. Class Rules
 1. Participate constructively.
 2. Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
 3. Remain quiet unless given permission to speak or sing.
 4. Remain seated unless given permission to stand (or vice versa).
6. Consequences
 1. Time Out
 2. Snack Detention (you have 5 minutes to get to the classroom)
 3. Email or phone communication with parents.
 4. Office Referral
 5. Class Suspension
7. Quiz Procedures
 1. Most quizzes are worth ten points and many include extra credit points.
 2. You may use your notes unless told otherwise.
 3. If you talk during a quiz, you are cheating. You will have to re-take the quiz during snack or before school.
 4. When finished, keep your quiz unless told otherwise.
 5. What to do when finished with a quiz:
 1. Read, homework, draw, snooze
 6. What NOT to do when finished with a quiz:
 1. Talk, pass notes
 7. We will correct quizzes in class most of the time. Instructions will follow as needed.
